Masters Division Playoff Pairings Party

The Friday pairings for the 45+ Division AAA, AA and A playoffs will be announced Thursday night at the Pairings Party, which will be held at **Pincher's Marina at Edison**, located near downtown at **2360 West 1st St.** All players are invited to attend.

The party will start at 7 p.m., with Pinchers supplying finger foods and a cash bar.

The pairings will be announced about 8 p.m. then posted by 9 p.m. at the World Series Headquarters, the Player Development Complex, on royhobbs.com and on the message line (239-533-7694)...

AAAA Pairings

As a result of meetings with managers of AAAA teams, the pairings for the Masters AAAA double-elimination playoffs were set.

The New England Braves, 2013 AAA winners, were mandated by rule to play AAAA in 2014 regardless of their 1-3 record. That made the Braves the 8th team in the division for the playoff.

The committee then polled the 2-2 teams in reverse seeding order and the Border City Brewers were the first in line to drop down and elected to do so.

In the team matchups, #7 Chicago Giants and #2 Puerto Rico Orioles played Tuesday, and by rule, the Giants had the option of changing games to face #1 HPK Oilers to avoid a rematch of a Tuesday game. The moved the NE Braves into the matchup with the Orioles. But both the Giants and Braves maintain their appointed seeds.

Picking up T-shirts

The tournament T-shirt is available **through Friday only** for all registered players outside the main concession stand near the Roy Hobbs Store in the screened in patio at the Player Development Complex. **No Shirts will be given out on the Saturday of your playoffs.**

Hours to pick up the Tournament T-shirt are from Noon to 6 p.m. With the shirt, each player will get a tournament patch. Exception is Wednesday when concessions are closed.

Players will need their RHWS ID card to get their shirts – No drivers licenses needed.

Pitching

For the record, here is a recap on the rules on pitching eligibility for the playoffs.

Roy Hobbs requirement is that all pitchers who will be starters or closers in save situations (3-run or less difference in the 8th and 9th innings) qualify for the playoffs by pitching at least 2 innings – 6 outs or 10 hitters – during pool play.

This is a reminder to all managers that all pitching statistics need to be updated through the first 4 games by noon Wednesday.

In Non-AAAA divisions, a pitcher may check-in for Thursday's game, but to pitch in the playoffs they must pitch 5 complete innings or face 21 batters Thursday.

Finally, in the playoffs, those "non-qualified" middle-inning pitchers will come to the mound from their normal defensive positions where they started the game. That is as important as the "spirit of the rule" that these *non-qualified* pitchers who are used as "inning-eaters" are players who ordinarily are playing other positions.
