14 added to RH Hall of Fame

Fourteen veterans of Roy Hobbs Baseball have been inducted into the Roy Hobbs Hall of Fame during the 2014 Roy Hobbs World Series.

Ten were honored in ceremonies at Pinchers Crab Shack Marina Edison Sunday night.

Almost 150 were in attendance to recognize for **Roger Begue** of Uniontown, Ohio, **Tommy Faherty** of Robbinsville, N.J., **David Mathews** of Tacoma, Wash., **Rick McGalliard** of Barberton, Ohio, **Joe Monari** of Justice, Ill., **John Morris** of Swannanoa, N.C., **Tom Scull** of Port St. Lucie, Fla., **Mic Stump** of Fircrest, Wash., **Joel Weinstein** of Monterey, Calif., & **Dutch Van Wey** of Truckee, Calif.

Previously, on November 4, **Bill Clary** of Fort Mill, S.C., **Bill Devine** of Pittsburgh, Pa., **Vito Ruscio** of Tinley Park, Ill., and **Richard Winstead** of Kodak, Tenn., were honored.

The Class of 2014 honors players, coaches, managers, administrators, and organizers whom the Trustees cited for outstanding contributions to the Game of Baseball, their teammates and baseball colleagues.

The 14 honorees bring the membership of the Roy Hobbs Hall of Fame to 31 in its first 2 years.

The Class of 2014 selection process started with a committee that took the nominations and interviewed the nominators and the listed references. Their reports were coupled with the nomination forms and forwarded to the existing members of the Hall of Fame and to the Board of Trustees, who reviewed more than 80 pages of data before casting their ballots.

The Roy Hobbs Hall of Fame, an offshoot of the Roy Hobbs Foundation (a 501c3 organization), is overseen by a Board of Trustees, chaired

Pitching

For the record, here is a recap on the rules on pitching eligibility for the playoffs.

Roy Hobbs requirement is that all pitchers who will be starters or closers in save situations (3-run or less difference in the 8th and 9th innings) qualify for the playoffs by pitching at least 2 innings – 6 outs or 10 hitters – during pool play.

This is a reminder to all managers that all pitching statistics need to be updated through the first 4 games by noon Thursday.

Finally, in the playoffs, those "non-qualified" middle-inning pitchers will come to the mound from their normal defensive positions where they started the game. That is as important as the "spirit of the rule" that these non-qualified pitchers who are used as "inning-eaters" are players who ordinarily are playing other positions.

Picking up T-shirts ...

The tournament T-shirt is available through Friday only for all registered players outside the main concession stand near the Roy Hobbs Store in the screened in patio at the Player Development Complex. No Shirts will be given out on the Saturday of your playoffs.

Hours to pick up the Tournament T-shirt are from Noon to 6 p.m. With the shirt, each player will get a tournament patch.

Players will need their RHWS ID card to get their shirts, no exceptions – No drivers licenses needed.

Results corrections

Please check the posted results and standings each day.

Managers should contact Rob at the Tournament Headquarters (239.533.7694) with corrections to scores.

That's the best way to make sure that playoff seedings and pairings are as accurate as we can make them.

10-, 15- & 20-year recognition

Have you been at the Roy Hobbs World Series 10 or more years?

If so, Roy Hobbs has a recognition pin for players with 10 or 15 or 20 years at the Tournament. See Karen or Rob at RHWS headquarters to get your pin.

Player ID cards

Just a reminder that all players must have their player I.D. cards with them at games.

No card, no play, and Roy Hobbs reserves the right to do card checks at games. Players without their ID cards will not be allowed to continue to play and will be required to bring his ID card to the Tournament Director or Site Manager before being allowed to return to the playing field.
