# Can-Am Padres a North American melting pot

The Tuesday morning game in the JetBlue Park stadium sported International flavor.

On one side were the Ukraine Kozaks and on the other side was a team of North Americans - the Can-Am Padres.

As the teams warmed up, Can-Am assistant manager B.J. Johnson was asked if he's Canadian or American.

"Chicagoan," Johnson said with a laugh.

So that makes for three nationalities on the Padres, if one counts Chicago as a separate country.

Seriously, the Padres are comprised of five Canadians and the rest are Americans from all across the fruited plain, virtually from sea to shining sea.

Padres manager Rob Raynor said he has players from Illinois, Ohio, New Jersey, West Virginia and Arizona. The Arizonan is Johnson, who moved from his native Chicago to Arizona five years ago.

And what about Raynor?

"Definitely Canadian," Raynor said.

The main thing the Padres look for in players isn't a nationality or hometown. They seek good guys and good players whose talent and congenial temperament make for a pleasant Roy Hobbs World Series.

Eric Thomas, who grew up in California but now resides

in New Jersey, is in his second season with the team. He said he had a "wonderful time" last year and wanted to return to the Padres.

He enjoys the playful banter with teammates and called it a lot of busting of chops, a practice that is a familiar part of baseball culture from high school teams to the big leagues.

Christopher Fanucci has ties to both countries. He grew up in Pennsylvania but now resides in Montreal. He's known Raynor for a long time and when he was asked to become a Padre he didn't have to think about his answer.

"I said absolutely," Fanucci said. "I came down last year. Absolutely love it and I'm here this year."

But how did this team of Canadians and players from states a long way from San Diego wind up being named the Padres? One doesn't need to be a geography wizard to know that San Diego is a heck of lot closer to the Mexican border than the Canadian border.

"They're my third favorite team," Raynor said of the Padres. His two favorites are the Toronto Blue Jays and Washington Nationals, who started life as the Montreal Expos. He didn't want to pick a Canadian or former Canadian team name.

So, he went with his third choice and now has a team with players from two countries. Well, three if one counts Chicago as another country.







#### First Aid

**Two key First Aid items:** Drink plenty of fluids while playing and before you get to the field; don't just wait until the game is over. Water will be available at the fields.

Second, be sure to stretch and loosen up before playing, or even re-entering a game.

In case of an emergency, contact the field manager at your site, or the concessions person if closer. We do have the First Aid supplies and will contact 911 services as needed.

Ice is available for injuries ... check with the field manager on duty or go to the nearest concession stand to have the appropriate personnel paged. Roy Hobbs requests that managers plan for pitchers needing ice for their arms and to supply it.


### Admission, \$1 a game



Players will pay their \$1 at check-in for their player ID card that guarantees them access to all games in which they are not playing. Spectators will pay \$1 for entrance into each complex and are good for one day.

The \$5 tournament pass is available at RH Headquarters or from the Site Concierges at each security table; there is no family pass. The tournament pass is a plastic card that guarantees admission for that person for the duration of the RHWS. A loop comes with the tournament pass card for easy attachment to purses, belt loops, etc.

## Playing site security

The active steps taken several years ago to deal with parking lot security will continue as parking lot theft issues have – knock on wood – not been an issue the last 7 years.

Are we out of the woods? No, it is a daily procedure and effort to make sure parking lots are safe.

Once again, Roy Hobbs will have personnel posted at the player/spectators' entrances to Terry Park, PDC, JetBlue Complex and at the entrance to the Quad fields at Lee County.

These individuals will have a view of the parking lot, and they will be available in emergencies, be enforcing cooler guidelines and handling admissions.



