

Krew namesake Harold Krueger 'lives, sleeps and eats baseball'

The name CWC Kruegers Krew didn't come out of a hat. It wasn't chosen at random or by lottery. Hardly.

It's a tribute to a man - Harold Krueger, who is 87 and resides in Rose Township, Michigan.

"He is the ultimate baseball nut," Krew member Steve Sarkon said Thursday before a game at CenturyLink against Cangrejeros RD. "He lives it. He sleeps it. He eats it. He wouldn't miss a game for an anniversary, a birthday."

Krueger was in Fort Myers the past two years serving as a bench coach, bat boy and all-around inspiration for the team, which was previously known as the Rhino Baseball Club.

"His heart is with us," Sarkon said. "We all love to play for him."

The name is a tribute that manager James Bailey insisted upon.

"If I have anything to do with the team moving forward it will be called Kruegers Krew," Bailey said.

That goal follows a request from Krueger,

"He asked me to keep the team going a couple of years ago," Bailey said. "He has some heart issues." So here they are, bearing his name.

"We want to honor him and be his crew," veteran player Gerald Davis, Jr. said.

To opponents the name may be a mystery. "They don't know the story behind it," Davis said. Team members are eager to tell the story.

"He's Mr. Michigan," Duane Weber said, Krueger, who worked 41 years for GM, is well-known in his Michigan as a huge fan of University of Michigan athletics. His Roy Hobbs players say he knows every Wolverine of note in recent and not-so recent history.

"He can call Desmond Howard on his cell phone," Davis said.

His players say Krueger knows or knew Michigan coaching legends such as Bo Schembechler and long-time baseball coach Bud Middaugh and current football coach Jim Harbaugh. What about one-time Michigan two-sport athlete Bill Freehan, who played football and baseball at Michigan in the early 1960s.

"He knows him," Sarkon said. "He knows them all."

Davis said Krueger has scouted many sports for Michigan over many years and in many sports. But there is something else that Davis values about Kruger even more than his scouting and passion for the game.

"A great man," Davis said, "One of the best men l've ever met. He's always got something positive to say about you or to you."

Now, all of Roy Hobbs Baseball knows the story of the man behind the name - Krueger's Krew.





Customer Service

Roy Hobbs Baseball is proud of its record on customer service.

Staff members are required to wear identifying staff shirts during the working hours of the tournament and should be easily identifiable. At least two are assigned to each of the satellite complexes daily.

In the case of **emergency**, please go to the nearest concession stand at the satellite complexes, where someone will be available to summon help.



HPK Oilers batter goes to right field vs. Pittsburgh Roy Hobbs field managers and key personnel are Red Cross First Aid **certified**, and Roy Hobbs Baseball has guidelines in place on the handling of injuries. Additionally, **AED devices** are available at each of the facilities, and Roy Hobbs personnel have been trained on those devices.

First Aid

Two key First Aid items: Drink plenty of fluids while playing and before you get to the field; don't just wait until the game is over. Water will be available at the fields.

Second, be sure to stretch and loosen up before playing, or even re-entering a game.

In case of an emergency, contact the field manager at your site, or the concessions person if closer. We do have the First Aid supplies and will contact 911 services as needed.

Ice is available for injuries ... check with the field manager on duty or go to the nearest concession stand to have the appropriate personnel paged. Roy Hobbs requests that managers plan for pitchers needing ice for their arms and to supply it.




