Huntsville's Ellis mixes RBIs with THAAD

Philip Ellis of the Huntsville Dirtbags is one of those un-seen Americans who make it possible to play baseball or go shopping or take the kids to grandma's house on Thanksgiving.

He works for something called the Missile Defense Agency, which is housed in the Department of Defense. Ellis works in the software division and is familiar with a defense system called THAAD. That stands for Terminal High Altitude Area Defense.

We're talking about things that go higher than major-league popups.

As Ellis walked across the PDC Sunday morning it seemed possible he is privy to information that might be classified.

"Everything I tell you will be on the news," Ellis said.

The Missile Defense Agency is described on its website as a "research, development and acquisition agency within" the Department of Defense.

THAAD is described as a "a transportable system that intercepts ballistic missiles inside or outside the atmosphere during their final, or terminal, phase of flight."

This work certainly seems more complicated than baseball players trying to remember their team's hit-and-run sign.

Ellis talked a little bit about his duties.

"In my particular job I'm actually allowed the opportunity to go out in the field with the units and the soldiers and see the equipment

work and participate in flight tests and ground tests," Ellis said. "So, I have the opportunity to talk with soldiers."

Ellis appreciates the chance to talk with soldiers because his late father was career Army.

"I'm a military brat," Ellis said.

His father, Craig, who died in 2003 at the age of 60, served two tours of duty in Vietnam.

"I heard all the Vietnam stories before he passed away," Ellis, 55, said.

Ellis travels frequently in his job to place such as Guam, Wake Island, Hawaii and Alaska for tests.

A week from today is Veterans Day, a special day for most Americans. That is certainly the case with Ellis for reasons other than patriotism and honoring all veterans.

"It is because of my dad," Ellis said.

Ellis grew up playing baseball and as an "Army brat:" that meant moving frequently and playing in more than one high school.

Not even teammates such as Roberto Alvarez, an Army vet who served 35 years, knows what Ellis does away from ballfields.

"I know he does something with missiles," Alvarez said. "But I'm not sure."

But whatever Ellis does it is certainly more complicated than remembering the indicator for stealing second base.





Playoff pitching guidelines Roy Hobbs requirement is that all pitchers who will be

Roy Hobbs requirement is that all pitchers who will be starters or closers in save situations (3-run or less difference in the 8th and 9th innings) qualify for the playoffs by pitching at least 2 innings – 6 outs or 10 hitters – during pool play.

AAAA qualifier teams may not add pitchers to their lineup after Pool Play concludes; however, Open Division teams may have pitchers arrive Wednesday – those pitchers much throw 5 innings or 25 hitters to qualify for the playoffs.

Finally, in the playoffs, those "non-qualified" middle-inning pitchers will come to the mound from their normal defensive positions where they started the game. That is as important as the "spirit of the rule" that these *non-qualified* pitchers who are used as "inning-eaters" are players who ordinarily are playing other positions.

And, please remember that any players leaving the RHWS today (Monday) to return on Thursday MUST turn in their player ID Card and re-check in upon their return. They must return before the quarterfinals of the playoffs, regardless of division.

Managers should email a list of their qualified pitchers to rg@royhobbs.com by 7 p.m. the night before their playoffs begin.

Picking up T-Shirts ...

The tournament T-shirt is available **through Friday only** for all registered players outside the Roy Hobbs Store in the screened in patio at the Player Development Complex. **No Shirts will be given out on Thursday or Saturday.**

Players will need their RHWS ID card to get their shirts in person, no exceptions. No driver's licenses needed.

Highlights and Statistics

We do all of our highlight submissions online now. The link to submit game highlights to e printed in the Inside pitches and on our website can be found on the Schedules page of the World Series website. The managers should have also received a link via email on the first day.

As for the end of tournament stats, every manager will be sent an Excel file and a PDF of the stats that we will be collecting after the whole tournament is done. It is not required. Teams may submit as much or as little as they want. Around the first part of January I will begin to combine all the stats I have and begin to sort out the Top Performances of the tournament. If you want to be in the running for a top performer spot, make sure your manager keeps good stats.



Two key First Aid items: Drink plenty of fluids while playing and before you get to the field; don't just wait until the game is over. Water will be available at the fields.

Second, be sure to stretch and loosen up before playing, or even re-entering a game.

In case of an emergency, contact the field manager at your site, or the concessions person if closer. We do have the First Aid supplies and will contact 911 services as needed.

Ice is available for injuries ... check with the field manager on duty or go to the nearest concession stand to have the appropriate personnel paged. Roy Hobbs requests that managers plan for pitchers needing ice for their arms and to supply it.


