

# Scott Harris' Grandfather, Teenie: A Legendary Photographer

Out of the thousands of men who play Roy Hobbs Baseball, few likely have a connection to the Negro Leagues as deep as that of Scott Harris of the Baltimore Orioles.

His late grandfather was legendary Pittsburgh photographer Teenie Harris, who photographed Josh Gibson, Satchell Paige, Jackie Robinson and many others.

But he was more than a sports photographer for the Pittsburgh Courier, a pre-eminent black newspaper. Teenie shot entertainers and political figures and everyday life in Pittsburgh.

He was so prolific and talented that the Carnegie Museum of Art in Pittsburgh has dedicated a permanent display of its collection of Teenie's images.

Late Tuesday afternoon his grandson sat in the living room of a Cape Coral house where he is staying this week with a few team-

mates and talked about his grandfather. Teenie died in 1998, about three weeks shy of turning 90. He left behind roughly 80,000 photos.

"It's considered to be the largest collection of photos depicting African-American life in the country," said Harris, who resides in Silver Spring, Md.

Harris, a retired banker, recalls his grandfather as a genial man who wouldn't go across the street for a celebrity's autograph but would make a fuss over regular people. For example, when the mail was delivered, Teenie would exclaim, "Hey! The mailman!"

He'd make the mailman feel special.

In recent years, baseball fans and others have learned about Teenie. The Baseball Hall of Fame published a profile of him earlier this year with the headline, "Heaven of Memory."

The Atlantic, a magazine catering to intellectuals, ran a feature on Teenie in 2021 with this headline: "Everybody Knew Teenie."

In 2001, the New York Times referred to Teenie's archive as "breathtaking in scope."

What would Harris want Roy Hobbs players to know about Teenie?

"I guess I would want them to really understand what his photos meant," Harris said.

The photos meant a great deal in the Black community, according to Harris. They showed real people as well as celebrities and provided glimpse of positive news the white

press did not always show.

When Teenie was in his 60s Roy Hobbs Baseball did not exist. He did not have the opportunity do what his grandson is doing - play baseball in his 60s.

What would Teenie think of his grandson playing at age 68?

"Well, first he'd have a big smile on his face," Harris said. "He would probably be saying I just can't believe that you're doing this. This is great. He'd be thrilled."

Scott Harris is thrilled to have Teenie Harris as his grand-father.

### First Aid

**Two key First Aid items:** Drink plenty of fluids while playing; don't just wait until the game is over. Water will be available at the fields.

Second, be sure to stretch and loosen up before playing, or even re-entering a game.

In case of an emergency, contact the field manager at your site. He has the First Aid supplies and will contact 911 services as needed.

**Ice is available for injuries** ... check with the field manager on duty or go to the nearest concession stand to have the appropriate personnel paged. Roy Hobbs requests that managers plan for pitchers needing ice for their arms and to supply it.


#### Playing site security
