Timeless: Florida Yankees, New Jersey Dodgers.


Classics: Livingston Dodgers, St. Louis Dodgers, Bergen Yankees.

The Bergen Yankees are located in Bergen County, N.J. That is across the Hudson River from New York City.

Bergen Yankees Rob Hubsmith and Jose Garcia grew up Yankee fans in New Jersey. They both have vivid memories of

their first trips as young boys to Yankee Stadium. Hubsmith said it was "painful" seeing the big-league Yankees lose in that other World Series.

"The better team won," Hubsmith said.

"I didn't think they were going to win," Garstin said.

The Florida Yankees played at the PDC Monday afternoon. Florida Yankees? Isn't that a contradiction in terms? Roy Heron explained that many of the players once played for the Long Island Yankees and now reside in Florida.

Not all.

Rich Degener resides in Cape May, N.J. Yankee fan?

"I'm a Cardinals fan," Degener said.

Teammate Gregg Balin is a Yankee fan who recalls going to Yankee Stadium in 1961 the day after Roger Maris hit his 60th homer of the season.

"Roger Maris did not play that day," Balin recalls.

The St. Louis Dodgers were at the Lee Health Sports Complex Monday. Their city's team plays home games in Busch Stadium, which is 1,827 miles from Dodger Stadium.

Other teams in local leagues claimed the Cardinals name. Manager Rick Tiek said he is a Red Sox fan but the team has at least one Dodger fan.

That is Greg Saylor, who grew up in Vero Beach, the former spring training home of the Dodgers. He has fond memories of meeting their fabled infield of Steve Garvey, Davey Lopes, Ron Cey and Bill Russell as a kid.

The Livingston Dodgers are from Livingston, N.J.

Why the name Dodgers for a team located 2,786 miles from Dodger Stadium?

They became the Dodgers because other teams in their local league beat them to the name Yankees. Roy Hobbs Hall of Famer Doc Pollak named the team.

Livingston manager Bill Currie isn't a Yankee fan.

"Unfortunately, we got some Yankee fans," Currie said. He joked they have to pay extra dues.

Pollak is a Yankee fan and referred to the big-league Dodgers as his team's "best minor-league club."

Maybe someday Shohei Ohtani, Mookie Betts and Freddie Freeman will earn promotions to the Livingston Dodgers.

4A pairings meeting & Wednesday games

Managers of potential 4A teams should plan to attend the AAAA pairings meeting Tuesday (today) at 5 p.m., or shortly thereafter, at PDC.

We will review records, runs-allowed, competition and W-L record for the week. It is possible for 2-2 teams to advance to the AAAA playoff.

We will also discuss the roster rules for the 4A playoffs so there will be no surprises on Thursday.

4A playoffs will begin Thursday at Lee Health Sports Complex.

Non-4AAAA games will be played Wednesday; teams will flip a coin for home team. Whenever RH has an odd number of teams, someone gets a bye Thru to the A playoffs. The 1-3 team with the most runs allowed is chosen in most cases but will call to notify the team.

Teams will be matched by record and there are no rematches; however, quite a few teams need a stadium game Wednesday and that will drive the pairings.

Thursday's 8-team 4A seedings and Wednesday's schedule will be found on the schedule page of Wednesday's Inside Pitch and at royhobbs.com.

Playoff pitching guidelines

Roy Hobbs requirement is that all pitchers who will be starters or closers in save situations (3-run or less difference in the 8th and 9th innings) qualify for the playoffs by pitching at least 2 innings – 6 outs or 10 hitters – during pool play, if they are in the dugout starting Sunday. If they check-in after Monday's games, they must pitch 5 innings (15 outs or 25 hitters).

AAAA qualifier teams may not add pitchers to their lineup after Pool Play concludes; however, AAAA teams may bring in 2 position players after Tuesday's games, but they must play the entire first game of the playoffs with no shared lineup options.

Finally, in the playoffs, those "non-qualified" middle-inning pitchers will come to the mound from their normal defensive positions where they started the game. That is as important as the "spirit of the rule" that these *non-qualified* pitchers who are used as "inning-eaters" are players who ordinarily are playing other positions.

And, please remember that any players leaving the RHWS today (Monday) to return on Thursday MUST turn in their player ID Card and re-register upon their return. They must return before the quarterfinals of the playoffs, regardless of division.


Score Reporting

Results corrections

Please check the posted results and standings each day. Managers should contact Rob at the Tournament Headquarters (234.200.8449) with corrections to scores.

That's the best way to make sure that playoff seedings and pairings are as accurate as we can make them.

Run-rule games

Run rule is 10 runs at 7 complete innings or if home team is ahead in a scheduled 9-inning game. Scheduled 7-inning games are 15 at 5 innings.

Now, in a 9-inning game, if the score difference is 15 at 5 innings, umpires have been instructed to call both managers together and to offer the team on the short end of the score if they want 6 outs to bat.

As far as RH is concerned the team ahead has won, but any runs scored will count in RA, so that is an incentive to not just put anyone out there to pitch.

Both teams must agree.

If you believe a game has been ended prematurely, don't leave and ask for a field manager; he will get in touch with headquarters for adjudication.
