Sean Broom's Facebook friends know about his annual Roy Hobbs World Series countdown posts.

For weeks, heck, even months, the Canton Tigers second baseman posts something every day with the number of days remaining until he plays in Fort Myers.

75 days. ....

59 days. ....

58 days. ....

And so on. ...

Each post contains a photo. Broom uses images of ballparks, sunsets, beaches, restaurants and, as his friends know, many disturbing images of implausibly morbidly obese gentlemen, often wearing Speedos.

It's a diverting pastime that helps Broom get fired up for the World Series.

"So, why not have fun with it?" Broom said Sunday morning before a game at the Lee Health Sports Complex.

Broom estimated he's been posting the countdown for "probably" 10 years.

Does he have a favorite image?

"My favorite picture is the sunset with the pier on Estero Island considering that the pier is not there," Broom said.

That Fort Myers Beach pier was destroyed by Hurricane Ian in 2022. That storm also forced the cancellation of the 2022 Rov Hobbs World Series.

Even before the countdown begins, friends inquire about it "People ask me when the countdown is going to start," Broom said.

"Everybody likes the fat guy working out pictures," Broom said.



### NOTEBOOK

#### Playoff pitching guidelines

Roy Hobbs requirement is that all pitchers who will be starters or closers in save situations (3-run or less difference in the 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> innings) qualify for the playoffs by pitching at least 2 innings – 6 outs or 10 hitters – during pool play, if they are in the dugout starting Sunday. If they check-in after Monday's games, they must pitch 5 innings (15 outs or 25 hitters).

AAAA qualifier teams may not add pitchers to their lineup after Pool Play concludes; however, AAAA teams may bring in 2 position players after Tuesday's games, but they must play the entire first game of the playoffs with no shared lineup options.

Finally, in the playoffs, those "non-qualified" middle-inning pitchers will come to the mound from their normal defensive positions where they started the game. That is as important as the "spirit of the rule" that these *non-qualified* pitchers who are used as "inning-eaters" are players who ordinarily are playing other positions.

And, please remember that any players leaving the RHWS today (Monday) to return on Thursday MUST turn in their player ID Card and re-register upon their return. They must return before the quarterfinals of the playoffs, regardless of division.

#### **Score Reporting**

There is a QR code posted in every dugout that we will be using. Scan the code with your phone after every game and complete the score submission form, which includes places for your Player of the Game and your umpire evaluations.

#### **Results corrections**

Please check the posted results and standings each day. Managers should contact Rob at the Tournament Headquarters (234.200.8449) with corrections to scores.

That's the best way to make sure that playoff seedings and pairings are as accurate as we can make them.

#### Run-rule games

Run rule is 10 runs at 7 complete innings or if home team is ahead in a scheduled 9-inning game. Scheduled 7-inning games are 15 at 5 innings.

Now, in a 9-inning game, if the score difference is 15 at 5 innings, umpires have been instructed to call both managers together and to offer the team on the short end of the score if they want 6 outs to bat.

As far as RH is concerned the team ahead has won, but any runs scored will count in RA, so that is an incentive to not just put anyone out there to pitch.

Both teams must agree.

If you believe a game has been ended prematurely, don't leave and ask for a field manager; he will get in touch with headquarters for adjudication.



#### First Aid

Two key First Aid items: Drink plenty of fluids while playing; don't just wait until the game is over. Water will be available at the fields.

Second, be sure to stretch and loosen up before playing, or even re-entering a game.

In case of an emergency, contact the field manager at your site. He has the First Aid supplies and will contact 911 services as needed.

Ice is available for injuries ... check with the field manager on duty or go to the nearest concession stand to have the appropriate personnel paged. Roy Hobbs requests that managers plan for pitchers needing ice for their arms and to supply it.
