Adam Johnson's Journey from MLB to Roy Hobbs

Adam Johnson's journey from No. 2 overall pick of the Minnesota Twins in the 2000 MLB Draft to the New Jersey Mets in the Roy Hobbs World Series is a long one.

Not just in terms of time that has passed since the Minnesota Twins selected him out of Cal State Fullerton.

The right-handed pitcher hasn't played professional baseball since 2009, when he wrapped up his career with the Orange County Flyers of the independent Golden League. His bigleague career was brief, 9 games split between 2001 and 2003 for the Twins. He was 1-3 with a 10.25 ERA.

Johnson is now a firefighter who works for the Lee County Airport Authority, splitting time between Southwest Florida International and Page Field.

But his love of the game remains the same as it was when he starred at Torrey Pines (Calif.) High School in the 1990s.

Although he wasn't in the big leagues long, he made it. He was in The Show. Out of the millions who play Little League and high school, few reach that level.

Johnson, 46, was one of the few. He recalls the sensation more than 20 years later.

"You're playing against your idols," Johnson said.

Johnson has been a firefighter for about 13 years. He sees similarities between the dugout of baseball and the world of fire houses.

"It's that camaraderie you get from sports," Johnson said.

With the Mets he still has sports camaraderie. He also gets to do things pitchers rarely do in pro baseball - play other positions and hit.

NJ Mets Manager Ken Fried said Johnson does it without any hint of a pro baseball resume.

"He doesn't big-time anybody," Fried said,

Johnson is just one of the guys, just another New Jersey Met.

"No way does he look for accolades, that he thinks he's more special than any other teammate," Fried said. "He is one of the most spirited supporters of the team. Great asset, even if he wasn't a great player."

Johnson's spirit and baseball IQ were apparent in the first inning of Sunday's game against the Minnesota WebGems. He worked a long at-bat to 3-2, fouling off several pitches before walking on a pitch just above the strike zone.

His teammates appreciated the at-bat.

"That a-way, Adam," a teammate shouted. "Great at-bat!" Sitting in the bleachers of Sunday's game was Roy Hobbs Hall of Famer Rob Fester.

Johnson played with Fester on the Pittsburgh Hitmen. Fester can tell without seeing them that Johnson's fastball is different.

"His pitches make a different sound," Fester said, He also liked having Johnson's humble nature.

"He was a fantastic teammate," Fester said.

That's probably true as well around the fire house.





Playoff pitching guidelines

Roy Hobbs requirement is that all pitchers who will be starters or closers in save situations (3-run or less difference in the 8th and 9th innings) qualify for the playoffs by pitching at least 2 innings – 6 outs or 10 hitters – during pool play, if they are in the dugout starting Sunday. If they check-in after Monday's games, they must pitch 5 innings (15 outs or 25 hitters).

AAAA qualifier teams may not add pitchers to their lineup after Pool Play concludes; however, AAAA teams may bring in 2 position players after Tuesday's games, but they must play the entire first game of the playoffs with no shared lineup options.

Finally, in the playoffs, those "non-qualified" middle-inning pitchers will come to the mound from their normal defensive positions where they started the game. That is as important as the "spirit of the rule" that these *non-qualified* pitchers who are used as "inning-eaters" are players who ordinarily are playing other positions.

And, please remember that any players leaving the RHWS today (Monday) to return on Thursday MUST turn in their player ID Card and re-register upon their return. They must return before the quarterfinals of the playoffs, regardless of division.

Run-rule games

Run rule is 10 runs at 7 complete innings or if home team is ahead in a scheduled 9-inning game. Scheduled 7-inning games are 15 at 5 innings.

Now, in a 9-inning game, if the score difference is 15 at 5 innings, umpires have been instructed to call both managers together and to offer the team on the short end of the score if they want 6 outs to bat.

As far as RH is concerned the team ahead has won, but any runs scored will count in RA, so that is an incentive to not just see NOTEBOOK on page 7


