# Actor Quijano lands part in RHWS cast

Alex Quijano is playing this week for the Glass City Black Sox under his real name - Alex Quijano.

The Los Angeles resident, 52, has a rich baseball pedigree going back to his days playing Little League and at the University California-Davis in the 1990s.

But dig around a little and one finds that he is also known as Uncle Richard and Mateo and Officer Bryson and Steve Crimson and simply a high school PE coach without a name.

Those are not criminal aliases. Qui-

jano is a bona fide thespian, a professional actor who said he has three loves in his life.

His wife, Alexandra, knows that.

"She knows that I have two loves in my life that are not her - baseball and acting," Quijano said.

Quijano's credits include a Netflix series, "My Life with the Walter Boys." He also acted in a Stephen Spielberg film, "The Fabelmans. He played a high school PE coach,

What if Spielberg or his people called with another role for a film that has a shooting schedule conflicting with

the Roy Hobbs World Series?

"Acting takes precedent," Quijano said. "It pays the bills."

His first speaking role was on a "Monk" episode. His character was simply Officer One. If his face is familiar, it may be from the more than 100 commercials Quijano has done from Coors to Chevy to Fiord to Cadillac.

His teammates derisively but affectionally call him "Hollywood" in a form of dugout banter every baseball player knows.

Black Sox Manager Gary Thompson used some of that banter describing Quijano's pitching.

"I always say he's very popular with other teams," Thompson said.

Thompson's playful bantering continued when he was asked if he and the team have seen "Life with the Walter Bovs."

"We all are forced to watch it," Thompson jokingly said.

Baseball is Quijano's release and sanctuary going back to college days majoring in biology and thinking of becoming a doctor. His study hall was often the UC-Davis baseball stadium. He feels the same way about other baseball parks.

"I could just sit in this park and just stare," Quijano said while sitting in a little room behind the third base dugout at JetBlue Park. "That's what I would do I would go to our stadium and read my homework."

Quijano makes the cross-country trip just about every fall for the chance to play in the Roy Hobbs World Series. He started playing baseball at the age of 6 for a Little League team called the Yankees.

He hasn't stopped.

"When you love it, you don't stop doing that thing you love," Quijano said.


He's still in love with baseball and acting and Alexandra. The couple are expecting their first child soon.



The ticket number will be posted on our website. You do not have to collect in person, just proof of the ticket.

#### No alcohol at sites

Roy Hobbs Baseball prohibits alcohol at all playing sites ... dugouts, inside fences and in the parking lots. Violators are subject to dismissal from the World Series, period.

#### Parkina

Please abide by parking guidelines, avoid no parking signs, fire lanes and curbs, and handicap spaces without a permit. Lee County Rangers are patrolling sites and will issue tickets to violators. They are not cheap.

#### First Aid

**Two key First Aid items:** Drink plenty of fluids while playing; don't just wait until the game is over. Water will be available at the fields.

Second, be sure to stretch and loosen up before playing, or even re-entering a game.

In case of an emergency, contact the field manager at your site. He has the First Aid supplies and will contact 911 services as needed.

**Ice is available for injuries** ... check with the field manager on duty or go to the nearest concession stand to have the appropriate personnel paged. Roy Hobbs requests that managers plan for pitchers needing ice for their arms and to supply it.

#### Admission, \$2 a game

Admission continues at the Roy Hobbs World Series.

Admission is \$2 per game or \$8 for a tournament pass. The player ID card grants players access to all games in which they are not playing. Spectators will pay \$2 for entrance into each complex and are good for one day at all complexes.

The \$8 tournament pass is available at RH Headquarters or from the Site Concierges at each security table; there is no family pass. The tournament pass is a plastic card that guarantees admission for that person for the duration of the RHWS. A loop comes with the tournament pass card for easy attachment to purses, beltloops, etc.
