# Cobra Kai father, son are baseball pals

The father-son duo of Philip and Marty Ham of Cobra Kai have been Roy Hobbs World Series fixtures for nearly a decade.

But their participation for this year's RHWS began with a promise which has not been kept.

"They promised us mermaids," Philip, 72, said before his team's 13-8 loss to the Tampa Mets Tuesday afternoon at Hammond Stadium.

There wasn't a mermaid in sight in

the first base dugout or on the field or in the stands.

But Philip and 47-year-old son Marty continue making the roughly 600-mile, 8-and-a-half-hour drive from Pensacola in the Florida Panhandle nearly every year. This is their eighth year at the World Series and fourth as Cobra Kai. They were previously known as the Sharks.

Their baseball and Pensacola connections run deep. Philip coached Marty in Little League. The family's ties to Pensacola go back to 1959, when Philip's dad, Eugene, a World War II Army Air Corps

vet, moved the family there. Philip was 6 at the time.

Although Philip no longer plays, he's still a part of Cobra Kai as a coach, score-keeper, and statistician.

The family ties extend well beyond dugouts and ballfields.

Philip and Marty run Ham's Pest Control, which is a family business that has been around since 1979. That was the year after Marty was born. Extended members of the Ham family operate the business.

From the company website: "A business that values family also values customers."

The family theme extends to baseball.

The years, though, take their relentless toll. Philip said it's about 10 years since he played.

Their connection to adult baseball goes back perhaps 27 years when Marty told his dad something.

"I found this men's league," Marty told his dad. "I'll get back in shape and play."

Philip didn't know how to take that.

"I said, 'What do you mean?"" Philip asked his son.

Now, they are still involved. They play in the Pensacola Men's Baseball League as well as in the World Series.


The World Series is a special time, even if they haven't encountered any mermaids. The Hams usually stay in a Cape Coral house and say the homes they rent are always "immaculate."

They enjoy playing teams from around the country and before war broke out, they played teams from Russia and Ukraine.

As Cobra Kai plays this week, they still have not seen a mermaid.

"But we keep thinking about it," Philip said. He has also come to a conclusion about the folks who told him about mermaids.

"It might be they lied to me," Philip said.



Roy Hobbs Baseball prohibits alcohol at all playing sites ... dugouts, inside fences and in the parking lots. Violators are subject to dismissal from the World Series, period.

#### Parking

Please abide by parking guidelines, avoid no parking signs, fire lanes and curbs, and handicap spaces without a permit. Lee County Rangers are patrolling sites and will issue tickets to violators. They are not cheap.

#### Water, Water Water

The heat in SW Florida can be debilitating, and overheating issues will sneak up on players. Get water every inning in the dugout!

#### Please help with dugouts

Roy Hobbs Baseball and the grounds crews need your help in the dugouts.

When your games are over and you are leaving the dugout, please police it for trash and cups, etc. Your assistance in cleaning up the dugouts each day will be greatly appreciated.

#### First Aid

**Two key First Aid items:** Drink plenty of fluids while playing; don't just wait until the game is over. Water will be available at the fields.

Second, be sure to stretch and loosen up before playing, or even re-entering a game.

In case of an emergency, contact the field manager at your site. He has the

First Aid supplies and will contact 911 services as needed.

Ice is available for injuries ... check with the field manager on duty or go to the nearest concession stand to have the appropriate personnel paged. Roy Hobbs requests that managers plan for pitchers needing ice for their arms and to supply it.

#### Playing site security

The active steps taken several years ago to deal with parking lot security will continue as parking lot theft issues have – knock on wood – not been an issue the last 7 years.

Are we out of the woods? No, it is a daily procedure and effort to make sure parking lots are safe.

Once again, Roy Hobbs will have personnel posted at the player/spectators' entrances to Terry Park, PDC, JetBlue Complex and at the entrance to the Quad fields at Lee County.

These individuals will have a view of the parking lot, and they will be available in emergencies, be enforcing cooler guidelines and handling admissions.

#### **Customer Service**

Roy Hobbs Baseball is proud of its record on customer service.

Staff members are required to wear identifying staff shirts during the working hours of the tournament and should be easily identifiable. At least two are assigned to each of the satellite complexes daily.

In the case of **emergency**, please go to the nearest concession stand at the satellite complexes, where someone will be available to summon help.

Roy Hobbs field managers and key personnel are Red Cross First Aid **certified**, and Roy Hobbs Baseball has guidelines in place on the handling of injuries. Additionally, **AED devices** are available at each of the facilities, and Roy Hobbs personnel have been trained on those devices.

#### Playoff pitching guidelines

Roy Hobbs requirement is that all pitchers who will be starters or closers in save situations (3-run or less difference in the 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> innings) qualify for the playoffs by pitching at least 2 innings – 6 outs or 10 hitters – during pool play, if they are in the dugout starting Sunday. If they check-in after Monday's games, they must pitch 5 innings (15 outs or 25 hitters).

AAAA qualifier teams may not add pitchers to their lineup after Pool Play concludes; however, AAAA teams may bring in 2 position players after Tuesday's games, but they must play the entire first game of the playoffs with no shared lineup options.

Finally, in the playoffs, those "non-qualified" middle-inning pitchers will come to the mound from their normal defensive positions where they started the game. That is as important as the "spirit of the rule" that these non-qualified pitchers who are used as "inning-eaters" are players who ordinarily are playing other positions.

And, please remember that any players leaving the RHWS today (Monday) to return on Thursday MUST turn in their player ID Card and re-register upon their return. They must

return before the quarterfinals of the playoffs, regardless of division.

#### \* \*

#### Run-rule games

Run rule is 10 runs at 7 complete innings or if home team is ahead in a scheduled 9-inning game. Scheduled 7-inning games are 15 at 5 innings.

Now, in a 9-inning game, if the score difference is 15 at 5 innings, umpires have been instructed to call both managers together and to offer the team on the short end of the score if they want 6 outs to bat.

As far as RH is concerned the team ahead has won, but any runs scored will count in RA, so that is an incentive to not just put anyone out there to pitch.

Both teams must agree.

If you believe a game has been ended prematurely, don't leave and ask for a field manager; he will get in touch with headquarters for adjudication.
