Traumatic injury no match for love of game

The line drive that smashed into pitcher Al Mignone's face on a summer day in 1999 in Eagan, Minnesota was heard by teammates and opponents.

Mignone, 71, of Minnesota Crosstown Traffic, said he was told what it sounded like.

"Like a pumpkin thrown from a building," Mignone said,

Although he lost the sight in his right eye but not the eye itself, Mignone still plays. He can't quit. Not ever. Not even a quarter century since that screamer off an aluminum bat broke bones in his face. It was in a Minnesota Federal League game,. The league then passed a rule banning aluminum bats.

What keeps him going?

"Just love of the game," Mignone said. "You can't keep a guy down, I guess."

Even on July 9,1999 in the moments after the ball crashed into his face, the athlete in Mignone prevailed. He wasn't knocked out.

"I was reaching for the ball to throw him out," Mignone said. Even at that moment.

"The blood was warm and running down my face," Mignone said.

He spent the next four days in a hospital.

Mignone spoke in the first base dugout at Terry Park 3 on Sunday morning. He sat on a bench but as soon as he heard the first few notes of the national anthem he sprung to his feet.

By the way, his last name is pronounced like filet mignon.

He wasn't supposed to pitch that 1999 summer day, a Friday. The original plan called for him to pitch two days later.

He obviously didn't pitch that Sunday. But now, 26 years later, he still pitches but he wears protective goggles for his right eye.

The man who hit the ball never apologized. It clearly was not intentional, but an apology might have been nice.

"I don't have any regrets," Mignone said. "I'm not afraid to go back out there."

Even with 272 little titanium screws in his face. The screws don't set off airport security alarms but are noticed when he visits a dentist office for x-rays.

"Everybody in the office wants to see it because they've never seen anything like it," Mignone said.

He still hopes sight can be restored in his right eye. The damaged optic nerve is the reason. If medical science fixes the damaged optic nerve?

"I would get my eyesight back," Mignone said. "My eye would come back to life because the only thing that got damaged was the optic nerve."

That line drive may have damaged the optic nerve in Al Mignone's right eye but not his love of the game.

Umpires act as Masters of Ceremonies ... ask all veterans to step forward for recognition and then take a moment of silence to remember any and all veterans each player knows.







So here's how we are getting scores: There is a QR code posted in every dugout. Scan the code with your phone after every game and complete the score submission form, which includes places for your Player of the Game and your umpire evaluations.

- Click on <u>royhobbs.com</u>. Some phones will show the royhobbs with a white outline. Then, you will see Game Schedule at the top of the page.
- 2. In the box that says search teams enter your team name.
- 3. Tournament is Roy Hobbs World Series beyond the 3 dots, it says 2025.
- 4. There is a Division dropdown. This week Legends 53+.

- 5. Then you see today's date.
- 6. Then your game(s) show up, and you click on Report Score.
- 7. You enter scores. When your opponent enters the score and they match then the score is confirmed.
- Then, as an option, you can enter player of the game (first and last names) and, if you wish, rate umpires.
- 9. Submit, and thank you.

Tickets are \$1 apiece or 6 for \$5. The drawing will be held in the patio area at the Player Development Complex at 5 PM Friday.

Playoff pitching guidelines

Roy Hobbs requirement is that all pitchers who will be starters or closers in save situations (3-run or less difference in the 8th and 9th innings) qualify for the playoffs by pitching at least 2 innings – 6 outs or 10 hitters – during pool play, if they are in the dugout starting Sunday. If they check-in after Monday's games, they must pitch 5 innings (15 outs or 25 hitters).

AAAA qualifier teams may not add pitchers to their lineup after Pool Play concludes; however, AAAA teams may bring in 2 position players after Tuesday's games, but they must play the entire first game of the playoffs with no shared lineup options.

Finally, in the playoffs, those "non-qualified" middle-inning pitchers will come to the mound from their normal defensive positions where they started the game. That is as important as the "spirit of the rule" that these *non-qualified* pitchers who are used as "inning-eaters" are players who ordinarily are playing other positions.

And, please remember that any players leaving the RHWS today (Monday) to return on Thursday MUST turn in their player ID Card and re-register upon their return. They must return before the quarterfinals of the playoffs, regardless of division.

No alcohol at sites

Roy Hobbs Baseball prohibits alcohol at all playing sites ... dugouts, inside fences and in the parking lots. Violators are subject to dismissal from the World Series, period.

Parking

Please abide by parking guidelines, avoid no parking signs, fire lanes and curbs, and handicap spaces without a permit. Lee County Rangers are patrolling sites and will issue tickets to violators. They are not cheap.

Water, Water Water

The heat in SW Florida can be debilitating, and overheating issues will sneak up on players. Get water every inning in the dugout!
