Umpire Eriksson is every shade of 'blue'

Umpire Erik Eriksson is guite likely the only Roy Hobbs World Series participant in its 36 years who is a blues musician born in Iceland and has served two terms as a city councilman in a Canadian community.

Oh, and his Blues name is Ice Blue. That's certainly fitting for this 79-yearold man in blue who comes from Iceland.

His family left Iceland when he was 5 and moved to Canada. Eriksson lives in Courtenay on Vancouver Island in British Columbia. That's on the west coast of Canada.

So, his commitment to Roy Hobbs umpiring as well as the Blues is clear. He's so far away he's north of the Great Northwest of the U.S.

It takes two flights from British Columbia to reach the Roy Hobbs World Series. The first flight is from Vancouver east to Toronto and then south to Fort Myers.

While in Florida the keyboardist and singer who was inspired by early Blues and rock and roll legends often jams at the Buckingham Blues Bar. That's about a 10-mile drive from the PDC.

As a younger man Eriksson worked as a sawmill electrician and representative for a union.


He comes from a musical family and as a boy started out on the violin. Then he discovered the piano.

"It was coming out of the '50s Blues and rock and roll," Eriksson said.

Jerry Lee Lewis' "Great Balls of Fire" was an early inspiration. So were the jumping magic of Fats Domino and Little Richard's "My Girl Josephine" was and is a favorite.

Back home Eriksson often plays parties. He also umpires in local leagues.

He's a man of few words who lets his calls on the field and keyboard artistry and singing do his talking.

Are there any MLB umps he particularly admires?

"No." Eriksson said.

Could he name one MLB umpire?

"No," Eriksson said.

What keeps Eriksson making the roughly 3,350mile journey to Fort Myers? He likes the friendly World Series atmosphere and he likes umpiring.

How often has he umpired here?

"I have no idea," Eriksson said.

Eriksson spoke between two games Sunday at the Lee Health Sports Complex. The first game he worked the plate and the second it was the bases.

He sat at a table at one of the backfields and chatted while scarfing down a hamburger and drinking a Pepsi.


The man who may be the only Icelandic participant ever in the Roy Hobbs World Series will return to his home island soon to attend a nephew's wedding.




