



# Cubs pair possess special baseball flair

The origin of the name for the Fort Myers Cubs is no mystery. All it takes is asking the right question to the right guy.

Yes, Wrigley Field is 1,299 miles from Terry Park, according to Google Maps. And the Cubs have spring training in Arizona.

But Fort Myers Cubs manager Tim McCoy is from Dixon, Illinois. As a boy, his favorite Cubs were Billy Williams and Ron Santo.

Hence the name Cubs.

Williams, who was always known as Sweet Swinging Billy Williams, played in 1,299 consecutive games from Sept. 22, 1963 to Sept. 2, 1970. It's the sixth-longest such streak in MLB history.

McCoy is also a Baseball Iron Man. And he's doing it at 71. McCoy has participated in four divisions over three weeks in the 2025 Roy Hobbs World Series. He doubled up one week.

He's playing more now than ever before. Why? The explanation is simple, one that many Roy Hobbs players no doubt understand.

"Because I had to work," said McCoy, who worked in construction trades in carpentry.

At his side for many years of his Roy Hobbs journey has been friend and teammate Al Hernandez. McCoy and Hernandez run the Cubs.

"I'm a Red Sox fan," said Hernandez, a retired electrical engineer for General Electric originally from Venezuela. "I moved here because of the Red Sox."

In 2012 the Red Sox moved their spring training home from City of Palms Park to JetBlue Park.

Like McCoy, Hernandez, 65, is participating in more than one week.

Why?

"I just love baseball," Hernandez said.

That's been the case from Little League days in Venezuela to trying out for the baseball team at Northeastern University in Boston. He did not make the team.

But he's still playing and playing multiple weeks. Any aches and pains?

"I feel perfect," Hernandez said Sunday morning at Terry Park before a game. "I can play 2 today.

"And I haven't been injured," Hernandez said.

These men respect each other.

"To me, Timmy is the epitome of a good guy," Hernandez said, "A real good guy. He gets along with everybody and has humongous baseball knowledge."

McCoy still recalls first meeting Hernandez at a local league game.

"Al showed up one day when we were playing the Sunday morning game just because he had heard about it," McCoy said.

Hernandez showed up in street clothes. That was about 12 years ago. He soon suited up and is still suiting up.

Legendary Chicago Cub Ernie Banks often said, "It's a great day for a ballgame. Let's play 2!"

How does that sound to Hernandez?

"Yes!" Hernandez said. "Absolutely!"

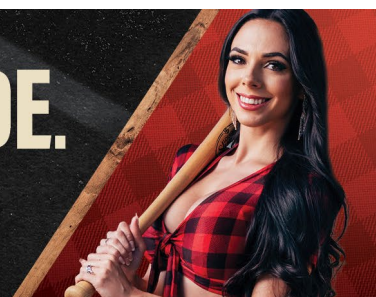

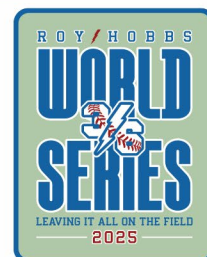

## Score Reporting System Primer

So here's how we are getting scores: There is a QR code posted in every dugout. Scan the code with your phone after every game and complete the score submission form, which includes places for your Player of the Game and your umpire evaluations.

1. There are two methods to provide your game scores.
2. **First method** you can enter into your browser [royhobbs.com/scores](http://royhobbs.com/scores) and then enter. You will see **Game Schedule at the top**. OR
3. **Second method** open the camera on your phone. Hold over the QR code located in all dugouts and you will see [www.royhobbs.com](http://www.royhobbs.com) outlined either in white or yellow. Click on the [www.royhobbs.com](http://www.royhobbs.com). This method will also take you to the **Game Schedule** Browse games and report scores.
4. Find Your Team- Select team from the dropdown and then click on your team.
5. Tournament is Roy Hobbs World Series beyond the 3 dots, it says 2025 **(Do not change)**.
6. There is a Division dropdown. This week it is Vintage-65+, ForeverYoung 75+, Antiques 80+. Click on your Division.
7. Then you see today's date and below this Status. **(Do not change status leave as All Statuses)**
8. Then your game(s) show up, and you click on Report Score.
9. You enter scores. When your opponent enters the score and they match then the score is confirmed.
10. Then, as an option, you can enter the player of the game (first and last names) and, if you wish, rate umpires. If you choose to rate the Umpires please complete all ratings.
11. Submit, and thank you.
