## Orioles, Ayala entrenched in RHWS history

Anybody asking how the Puerto Rico Orioles became the Orioles might be surprised to learn that the name has nothing to do with being a fan of the Baltimore Orioles.

Or being a fan of legendary Orioles such as Brooks Robinson, Frank Robinson, Jim Palmer, Cal Ripken or Eddie Murray.

Nope. it was a fashion choice. Really.

Manager Alfred Ayala explained it Tuesday morning sitting in the bleachers at JetBlue Field 5 before a game. At their league back home in Puerto Rico, teams must dress in MLB uniforms with MLB names.

So, what team and what uniform?

"The most beautiful that we found was the Baltimore Orioles," said Ayala, who is a physician.

Ayala is as much a Roy Hobbs World Series fixture as nearly any other player or manager in the event's long history.

He's been bringing teams to Fort Myers since 1994. Ayala is a charter member of the Roy Hobbs Hall of Fame. He was inducted with the inaugural class in 2013.

Another factor luring Ayala back year after year is strict adherence to rules and protocol.

"You're trying to do things the right way," Ayala, 67, said. He admits to being a stickler for the rules.

"I like that," Ayala said of adherence to rules.

Eugene Hemphill of the Orioles has known Ayala since before the birth of Roy Hobbs Baseball. As Hemphill recalls,

their paths first crossed in amateur baseball in 1981 or 1982 when Ayala was doing his residency. Hemphill knows that the same intelligence and organization that allowed Ayala to graduate medical school and become a doctor is found on baseball fields and in dugouts.

"He's always been an organized person," Hemphill said. "He always goes by the rules. Doesn't try to cut corners."

What keeps Ayala and the Orioles making that journey from San Juan to Fort Myers every fall?

"The tournament itself because it's the most organized tournament," Ayala said.

Ayala, who is also an acupuncturist, said he is committed to his players.

"When you're managing you don't have four at-bats," Ayala said. "You have 35 at-bats. Every time a player does something you're thinking and trying to help everybody do their best. I like that."

"I like trying to communicate strategies. And

managing a team you're dealing with a lot of different characters."

Ayala isn't as busy now in his career as he was in the 1990s. He now works three days a week.

"I'm not doing any more medicine," Ayala said. "I'm only doing acupuncture right now. To do acupuncture in Puerto Rico you have to be a doctor of medicine."

One probably does not need to be a Roy Hobbs Hall of Famer to practice acupuncture in Puerto Rico.

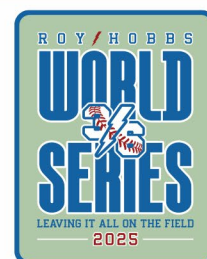

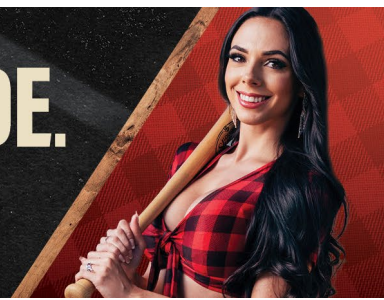

pitchers who will be starters or closers in save situations (3-run or less difference in the 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> innings) qualify for the playoffs by pitching at least 2 innings – 6 outs or 10 hitters – during pool play, if they are in the dugout starting Sunday. If they check-in after Monday's games, they must pitch 5 innings (15 outs or 25 hitters).

AAAA qualifier teams may not add pitchers to their lineup after Pool Play concludes; however, AAAA teams may bring in 2 position players after Tuesday's games, but they must play the entire first game of the playoffs with no shared lineup options.

Finally, in the playoffs, those "non-qualified" middle-inning pitchers will come to the mound from their normal defensive positions where they started the game. That is as important as the "spirit of the rule" that these *non-qualified* pitchers who are used as "inning-eaters" are players who ordinarily are playing other positions.

And, please remember that any players leaving the RHWS today (Monday) to return on Thursday MUST turn in their player ID Card and re-register upon their return. They must return before the quarterfinals of the playoffs, regardless of division.

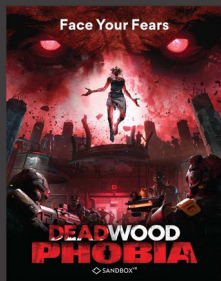
