



A cardiac arrest with a happy ending

An Avive AED saved Keenan Brown's life a year ago. This week Avive sent a video crew to film Brown returning to the baseball fields of Lee County.

Keenan Brown's life was saved in the 2024 Roy Hobbs World Series thanks to quick thinking by Lee Heath field manager Tony Nazzaro and his training on how to use an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) manufactured by a company called Avive.

Brown's story is being documented by Avive, which sent a team of four to Fort Myers this week to produce a video. Brown is with JD's Jaguars.

Brown is a father of six. His wife, Janine, was at the 2024 World Series but was not in attendance at the Lee Health

Sports Complex where Keenan was stricken.

Katerina Miras, Avive's vice president of marketing, headed the team that visited Fort Myers.

Miras said her company heard about Brown through a partnership with Lee County. The AED is connected to what Miras called her company's "dashboard." Data from AEDs is collected in the dashboard so Avive knew the device Nazzaro used had been employed to save a life.

Brown playing baseball helps Avive humanize the AED story.

"It's everyday people doing everyday things," Miras said.

"You can be in the fittest health. You can be someone who isn't as healthy. It doesn't matter. Gender doesn't matter. Your age, ethnicity doesn't matter. Cardiac arrest can happen anywhere."

It happened to Brown before a game.

"I felt absolutely fine," Brown said.

He was reaching for a ball in warm-ups when he was felled.

A teammate threw the ball a little high. Brown reached and jumped and that was it.

"Don't remember anything," Brown said. "Until I woke up four minutes later."

Years ago, a person in similar circumstances might not have ever awoken again. But Nazzaro, who is trained on the AED, was there.

"It was like the perfect setup to have that device there," Brown said.

Janine was at a hotel when she got a call every spouse dreads.

"Oh, my, God, this is my husband," Janine said,

She started to panic. All she knew initially is that Keenan had collapsed at Lee Health and was on his way to Gulf Coast Medical Center. Keenan had taken their rental car to the field. A friend drove Janine to the hospital.

Keenan and Janine brought their three youngest children

to Fort Myers to see where their father was stricken. The children: Toria, 14, Lyric, 12, and River, 11.

Avive finds the comeback compelling.

"We can all understand that Keenan is a father, a husband, a friend, a colleague," Miras said. "And doing something he loves and he collapsed and yet here he is a year later doing the same thing. So, it's a beautiful story."

Miras hopes to post the video by the end of the year on the Avive website.





Playoff pitching guidelines

Roy Hobbs requirement is that all pitchers who will be starters or closers in save situations (3-run or less difference in the 8th and 9th innings) qualify for the playoffs by pitching at least 2 innings – 6 outs or 10 hitters – during pool play, if they are in the dugout starting Sunday. If they check-in

after Monday's games, they must pitch 5 innings (15 outs or 25 hitters).

AAAA qualifier teams may not add pitchers to their lineup after Pool Play concludes; however, AAAA teams may bring in 2 position players after Tuesday's games, but they must play the entire first game of the playoffs with no shared lineup options.

Finally, in the playoffs, those "non-qualified" middle-inning pitchers will come to the mound from their normal defensive positions where they started the game. That is as important as the "spirit of the rule" that these *non-qualified* pitchers who are used as "inning-eaters" are players who ordinarily are playing other positions.

And, please remember that any players leaving the RHWS today (Monday) to return on Thursday MUST turn in their player ID Card and re-register upon their return. They must return before the quarterfinals of the playoffs, regardless of division.



No alcohol at sites

Roy Hobbs Baseball prohibits alcohol at all playing sites ... dugouts, inside fences and in the parking lots. Violators are subject to dismissal from the World Series, period.



Parking

Please abide by parking guidelines, avoid no parking signs, fire lanes and curbs, and handicap spaces without a permit. Lee County Rangers are patrolling sites and will issue tickets to violators. They are not cheap.



Water, Water Water

The heat in SW Florida can be debilitating, and overheating issues will sneak up on players. Get water every inning in the dugout!



Run-rule games


Run rule is 10 runs at 7 complete innings or if home team is ahead in a scheduled 9-inning game. Scheduled 7-inning games are 15 at 5 innings.

NOTE, in the 70s & 75s divisions, if the score difference is 15 at 5 innings, umpires have been instructed to call both managers together and to offer the team on the short end of the score if they want 6 outs to bat.

As far as RH is concerned the team ahead has won, but any runs scored will count in RA, so that is an incentive to not just put anyone out there to pitch.

Both teams must agree if the game is not continued.

If you believe a game has been ended prematurely, don't leave and ask for a field manager; he will get in touch with headquarters for adjudication.


