'First to Third' podcast fun for Klyczek

Kevin Klyczek' podcast is all baseball, all the time. He focuses on adult amateur baseball in the Chicago area.

The name of Kevin Klyczek's podcast immediately and clearly shows what it is about.

The First to Third ChicagoLand podcast is not about knitting or bird watching or stamp collecting.

It is all baseball, all the time. The focus is almost exclusively adult amateur baseball in the greater Chicago area. It was launched in January of this year.

Klyyczek is playing this week with the

SouthEast Cardinals. He's been thinking about launching a baseball podcast for several years, but it was postponed for reasons such as COVID-19.

The podcast is a natural move for Klyczek, who is a cigar salesman. His formal title is Director of National Sales at Kretek International.

He has an amiable manner that suits selling cigars or podcasting. Plus, he has the baseball background and local knowledge.

"I know the players," Klyczek said

Monday morning before a game at the Lee Health Sports Complex. "I know the managers."

His target audience is the eight leagues, 27 divisions and 2,000 or so players scattered around Chicago. He recently posted the 40th episode of the podcast.

New episodes are dropped once a week. A system is now in place to create the podcast. He tapes and edits the

show from the basement of his home in St. John, Indiana. By Tuesday or Wednesday, he's ready to "drop" the next episode on his website and Facebook account.

The female voice heard on the podcast is that of his wife, Debbie. She helped create the podcast's logo of the silhouette of a right-handed batter appearing ready to swing

Is Klyyczek ready to quit his day job to become a full-time podcaster?

"Probably not anytime soon," Klyczek said. "But I'm having fun doing it."

Jay Sannazzaro of the Cardinals has been on the team for 10 years and listens to the podcast.

"Absolutely," he said. "Pretty much every week. It's talking about baseball and someone I know talking very intelligently about the game."

Glenn Luckinbill of the Cardinals is a loyal listener. He now resides in Nashville, Tennessee. The podcast keeps him connected to old friends and teammates in Chicago.

"It's nice to hear how everybody's doing," Luckinbill said. That's not all.

"I think he's definitely got a talent for it," he said of Klyczek. "I love his Chicago accent. Makes me feel a little bit back home."

For Episode No. 41, Roy Hobbs president Tom Giffen is scheduled to be a guest. That episode will drop tonight.





Score Reporting System Updated

The system – Mighty Forms – we were using in the past went belly up 10 days ago after a massive internet meltdown.

So here's how we are getting scores: There is a QR code posted in every dugout. Scan the code with your phone after every game and complete the score submission form, which includes places for your Player of the Game and your umpire evaluations.

- Click on <u>royhobbs.com</u>. Some phones will show the royhobbs with a white outline. Then, you will see Game Schedule at the top of the page.
- 2. In the box that says search teams enter your team name.
- 3. Tournament is Roy Hobbs World Series beyond the 3 dots, it says 2025.
- 4. There is a Division dropdown. This week Legends 53+.
- 5. Then you see today's date.
- 6. Then your game(s) show up, and you click on Report Score.
- 7. You enter scores. When your opponent enters the score and they match then the score is confirmed.
- Then, as an option, you can enter player of the game (first and last names) and, if you wish, rate umpires.
- 9. Submit, and thank you.




